THE PASTOR’S REFLECTION

Patience is a virtue admired in farmers who patiently wait for the fruits of their labor. God is also patient when he sows the word in people's hearts. In the Book of Isaiah, we see how God's word is powerful and reaches where it is meant to bear fruit. In the Letter to the Romans, Paul reminds us that we await the fullness of God's kingdom, and the suffering we experience is part of the path to eternal joy. God doesn't come with the full result immediately, but with patience, he allows time for faith to grow in our hearts. The Gospel shows how different hearts respond to God's word. God patiently waits for us to understand, accept His teachings, and allow them to bear fruit in our lives. How will we respond to God's word?

PILGRIMAGE TO THE SHRINE OF CANADIAN MARTYRS IN MIDLAND

The Polish Priests' Conference for Eastern Canada cordially invites its compatriots to the 70th Pilgrimage of the Polish Community in Ontario to the Shrine of the Canadian Martyrs in Midland, which will take place on Sunday, August 9, 2026. This year's celebration will be led by the President of the Polish Episcopal Conference, Archbishop Tadeusz Wojda of Gdańsk. During the ceremony, a new Polish Altar will be dedicated. Program of the indulgence ceremonies: 10:30 AM - Rosary; 11:15 AM - Entrance of the walking pilgrimage; 11:30 AM - Solemn Mass of the indulgence; 1:00 PM - Devotion, blessing of herbs and flowers.
